	Sound of phone ringing
<i>Female operator:</i>	“National Security Hotline”
<i>Male caller:</i>	“Oh hi, I wouldn’t usually call, but I overheard something that sounds suspicious....”
<i>Female caller 1:</i>	“...Well they have a lot of pool supplies in their courtyard, but they don’t have room for a pool...”
<i>Female caller 2:</i>	“The name on his credit card didn’t match the one on his passport.”
<i>Male voice-over:</i>	“Your detailed information could help keep Australia safe. So if you see or hear something that just doesn’t feel right, call the National Security Hotline on one eight hundred, one two three four, double ‘0’ (1800 1234 00). You can remain anonymous. National Security. Every detail helps.”
